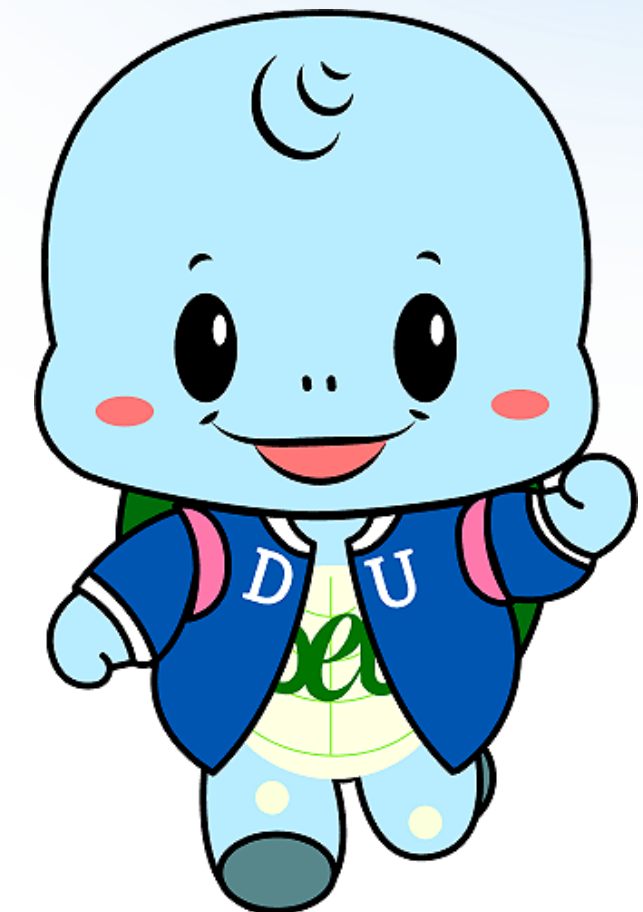

# Purpose



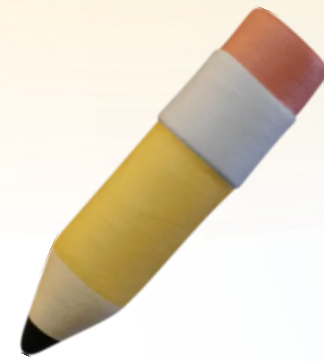
It is a international academic and cultural exchange program for students who have been selected through the screening process and approved by both Dong-Eui University and Home University.

Please first send the nomination list and individual student applications including all docs by email.

- **Deadline: Nomination - May 15th / Application - May 30th**
- Note: After sending us the nomination list, please send the original copies of application documents to the International Exchange Team by post(EMS). Also, the documents must be sent by the institution, not the applicants themselves.

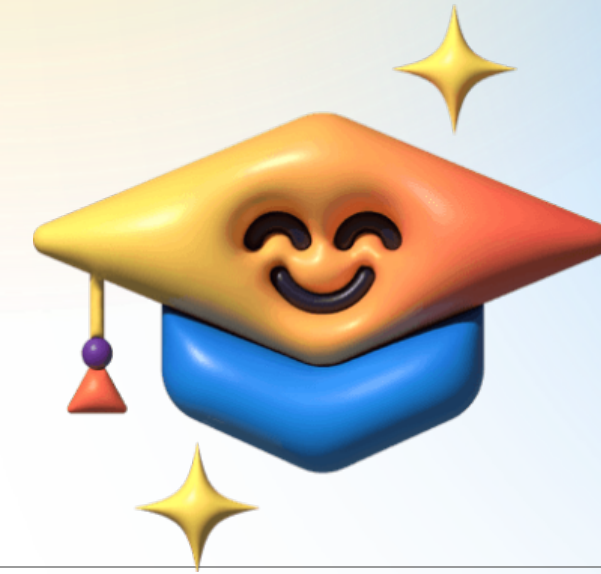

Please check the list of departments on our university website and select a major that is **closest** to the student's home university major. \*Refer to the [DEU Major Lists].

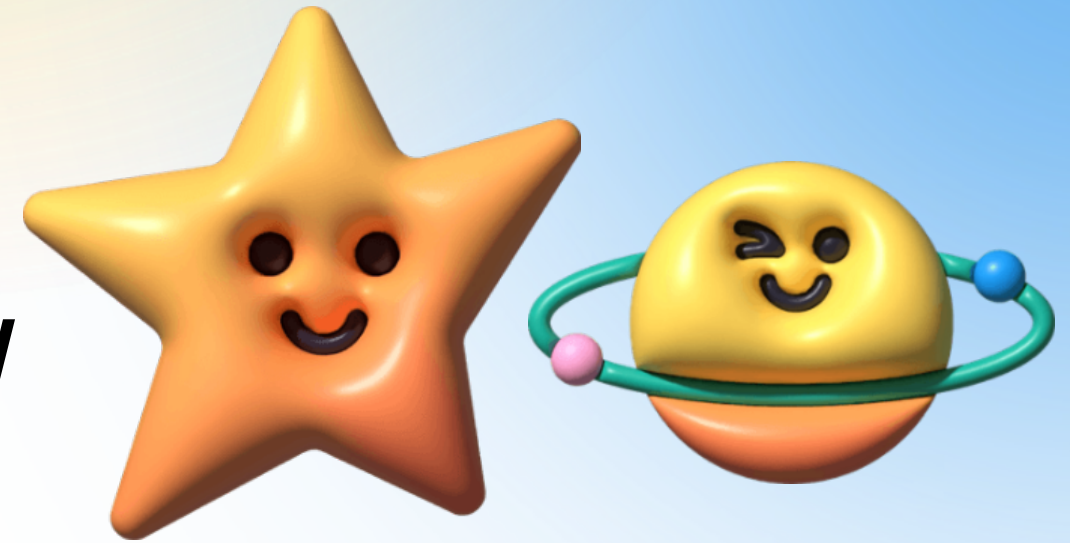
After receiving the individual's applications, we will contact the relevant departments to **confirm** whether it is possible to accept the incoming Japanese exchange student.

# Insurance

National Health Insurance is mandatory.  
(After entering Korea, you will be automatically enrolled, and a monthly bill of approx.  
150,000–160,000 KRW will be issued.)

The Office of International Affairs does not encourage, guide, or support exemption from  
National Health Insurance.

We kindly ask that you do not recommend insurance exemption to students.  
For safety reasons, please provide guidance in the most cautious and conservative way.
